Meal In A Bag

- Canned tuna, Tuna Helper, canned peas and canned peaches
- Spaghetti Sauce, spaghetti, canned green beans and Jell-O
- Pancake mix, syrup and canned fruit
- Soup, crackers, peanut butter, jelly and cookies
- Boxed cereal, powdered milk, apple juice, canned fruit

Non-Food Items

- Razors, shaving cream, bar soap and deodorant
- Shampoo, conditioner, liquid soap and lotion
- Toilet paper, paper towels, facial tissues and feminine hygiene products
