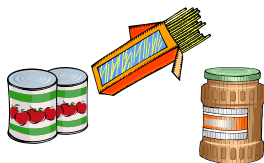
Academic Support Programs are available for children who need extended instructional support beyond the regular school day. Information regarding these programs will be provided in the Media Center.
